Pastor's Perspective

It all started back in the summer of 1969.



Now, needless to say I wasn't there. But that was the first summer that a then small organization known as Christ in Youth (CIY) held a summer conference with the primary goal of bringing the gospel of Christ to teenagers in deliberate and innovative ways. Since then, CIY has expanded their mission to include about a half dozen different conferences that target various age groups and areas. They lead service groups in different areas across America. They hold summer conferences abroad in such areas like Southeast Asia and Africa. What else is amazing, is that the conference that started it all back in 1969, is still going strong and reaches over 20,000 high school students through 22 summer conference events. Since the summer conference's inception, their dedication to ministering to students through new and effective means has stayed the same. The only change? Instead of calling it CIY Summer Conference a couple of years ago they re-branded it to MOVE.

And that, my friends, is where a group of our students will be going from July 12-17.

Though the attendance numbers are not completely set yet, that week over 30 people from Madison Christian Church will be going to Lee University in Cleveland, Tennessee. CIY's MOVE conference features cutting edge music and speakers to effectively speak to teens where they are. And that's only the tip of the iceberg! Each year CIY manages to innovate and broadcast the message of the gospel in new ways designed to make students think and grow in their faith in ways they often don't expect. Even though I personally have gone to CIY each summer since 2003, they still manage to surprise me with their methods.

Be praying for our students as we prepare to embark on this exciting journey. Our students will experience God in amazing ways that week, and will also be challenged to take steps of their own to fulfill God's mission for their lives. I don't know everything that will happen that week but I do know this: God *will* be moving.

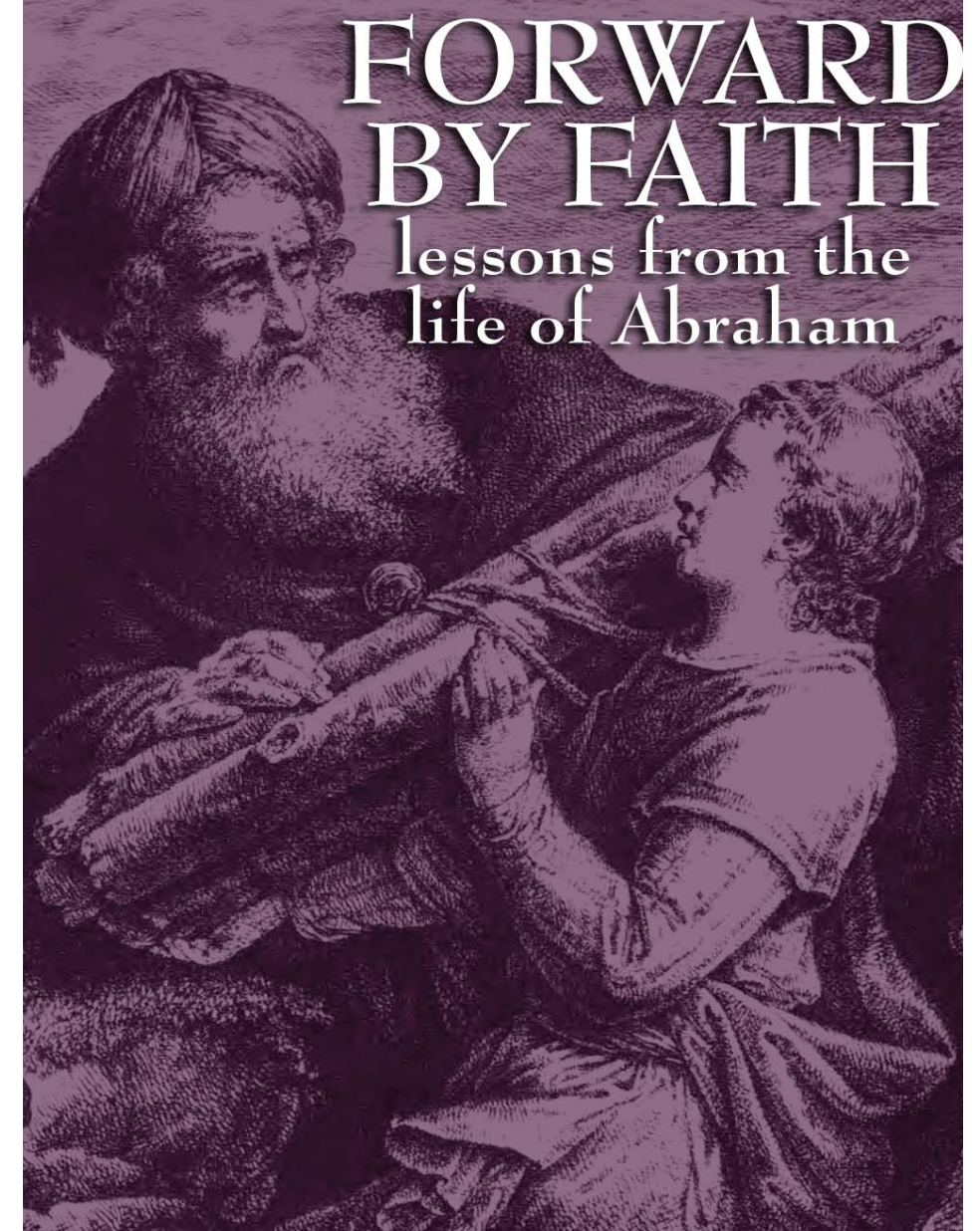
