Leviticus 16

Hebrews 10:11-14

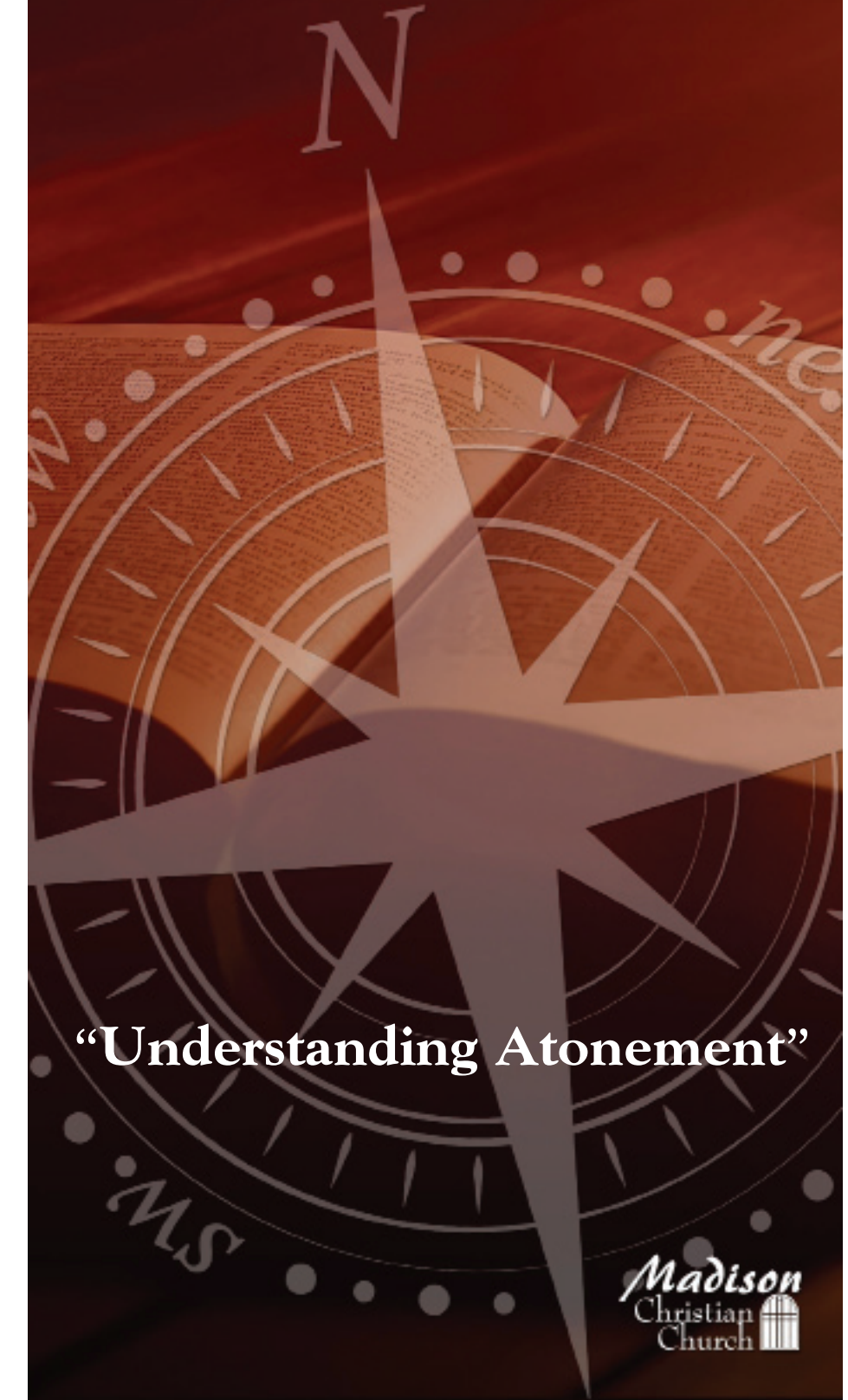
Aaron entered behind the veil - Christ tore it wide open.
