BAPTISM

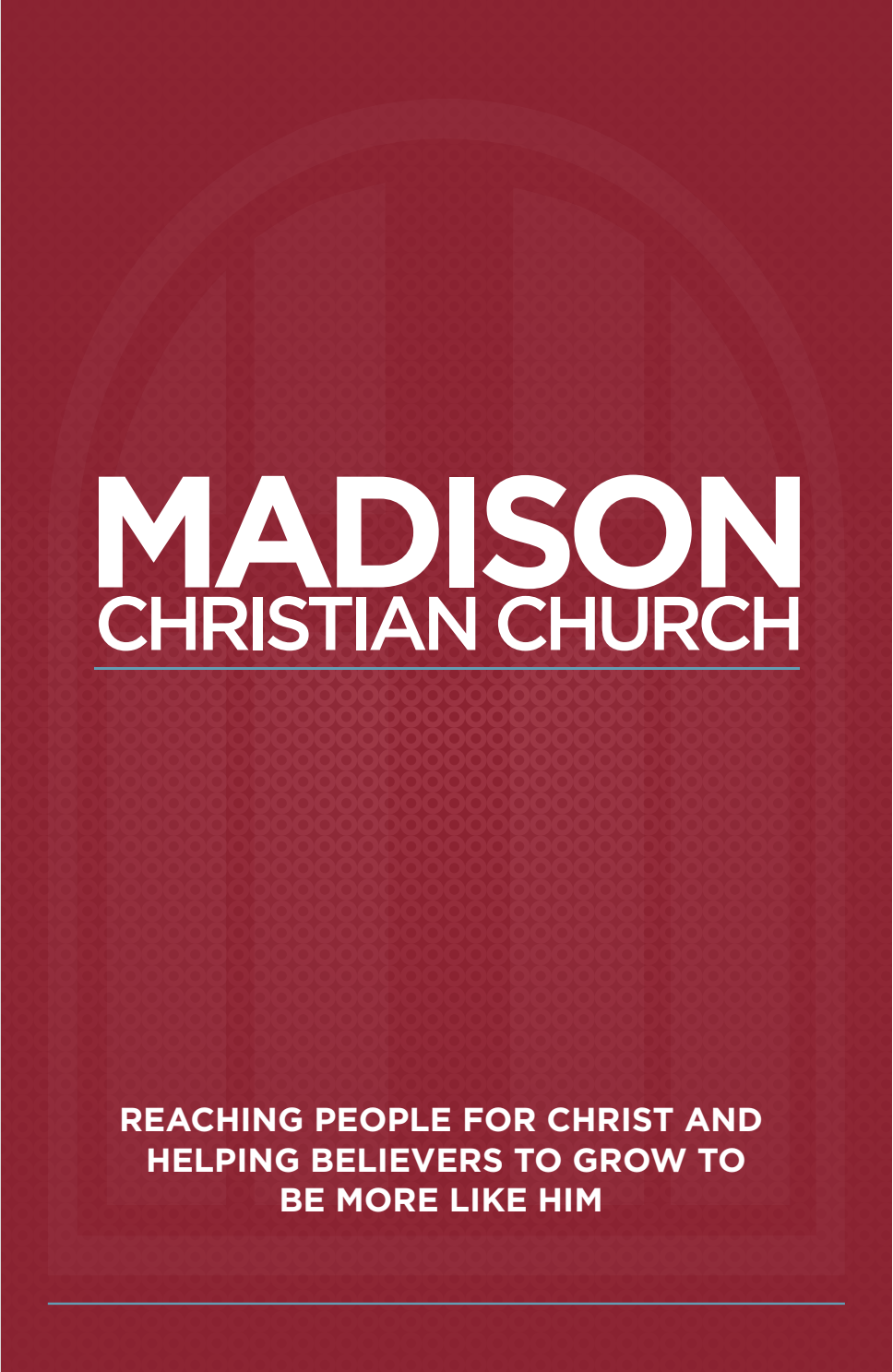
