“A Prophet Like Moses”

Hebrews 11:23

Deuteronomy 18:18

1-Moses was rescued as a youth from a desperate monarch and delivered in Egypt. Jesus was rescued as a youth from a desperate monarch.

2-Moses was called “the meekest man on the face of the earth.” (Nu. 12:3) Jesus was “meek and lowly in heart,” offering rest to people’s souls. (Mt. 11:29)

3-Moses supplied the Israelites with manna to eat daily in the wilderness. Jesus was the bread of life that brought lasting satisfaction.

4-Moses was a lawgiver, bringing the commandments from Mt. Sinai. Jesus obeyed the law perfectly and fulfilled the law. (Jn. 1:17)

5-Moses was the mediator of the Old Covenant. Jesus was the mediator of the New Covenant.

6-Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness and people looked at it to be saved. Jesus was lifted up on a cross and to this day people look to him to be saved eternally.

7-Moses was preserved by God’s hand as a baby, and the hand of God dug his grave when he died. Jesus was preserved by God’s hand as a baby and raised from the dead by God’s hand after his crucifixion.

8-Moses delivered his people. Jesus delivered his people.

9-Moses was faithful. Jesus was faithful. He was BOTH faithful and flawless.

10-Moses was treated shamefully by those he led. Jesus was treated shamefully by those he came to save.

11-Moses introduced the importance of blood. Jesus shed his blood to save us.

12-Moses provided the only way when the Israelites’ backs were to the wall. Jesus provides the only way when our backs are to the wall.
