

# MCC Student Ministry Reopening Plan

1. Student ministry will resume for Wednesday night assemblies beginning September 9<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 PM – 7:30 PM
2. Weather permitting, all student ministry assemblies will take place outside (Fire Pit) during the months of September and October. In the event of poor weather conditions, functions will be moved indoors to the gymnasium or chapel area.
3. Any student that has symptoms of being sick cannot attend student ministry functions (Symptoms include, but are not limited to: cough, runny nose, congestion, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat or new loss of taste or smell)
4. All students need to check in with student ministry volunteers at 6:30 PM to have temperature checked and to be assigned to a small group pod. These volunteers can be identified by wearing orange safety vests.
5. Students will be assigned to small group pods. All students must remain with their assigned small group pod for the duration of the assembly.
6. Hand sanitizer will be available for use at each small group pod station.
7. Following CDC guidelines, a social distancing protocol of 6 feet will be facilitated and maintained between individuals at all times during student ministry functions.
8. All students and student ministry volunteers are expected to wear masks for the entire duration of student ministry functions, unless medically unable to do so.
9. There will be no food, snacks or refreshments provided during student ministry functions until further notice.
10. These measures are subject to change, and or modification in the future by MCC leadership.
